- BE COURTEOUS AT ALL TIMES TO FELLOW ROAD USERS.
- OBEY THE RULES OF THE ROAD.
- RIDE RESPONSIBLY AND PREDICTABLY



- CAPTAIN AND MARSHALL MUST NOT BE LATE.
- **COUNT HOW MANY RIDERS THERE ARE.**
- IDENTIFY ANY GUESTS, WELCOME THEM AND APPRAISE THEIR RIDING ABILITY
- BEFORE DEPARTING CHECK WHO IS GOING THE FULL DISTANCE AND WHO WILL GO SHORT.
- ASSIST NEW AND UNFIT RIDERS TO PLAN A SHORTER ROUTE.
- **BUDDY SYSTEM FOR NEW RIDERS.**
- NOMINATE ADDITIONAL MARSHALS IF NEED BE.
- 36 SPLIT THE GROUP IF NEED BE BASED ON ABILITY AND SIZE.



- BUDDY SYSTEM FOR PUNCTURES, MARSHALL DECIDES WHO STOPS.
- RIDE TWO ABREAST, NEVER MORE, AND SINGLE FILE WHERE REQUIRED.
- **DICTATE THE PACE OF THE GROUP.**
- NO GAPS IN THE GROUP SO CARS CAN PASS EASILY.
- **STICK TO THE LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD.**
- RIDE INSIDE THE EMERGENCY LANE IF THERE IS ONE, AS CLOSE TO THE EDGE AS IS SAFE, AVOIDING CARS AS FAR AS POSSIBLE.
- RE-GROUP IF NEED BE WHERE IT IS SAFE TO DO SO.
- COMMON SENSE TO BE APPLIED IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY.



- **DO NOT CHANGE THE ROUTE PLANNED EXCEPT FOR EMERGENCIES.**
- THE CLUB MUST BE NOTIFIED IF THERE IS A CHANGE IN ROUTE.
- **CAPTAIN AND MARSHALLS TO BE OBEYED AT ALL TIMES.**
- **CARRY A PHONE AND ENSURE THAT YOU ARE CONTACTABLE.**
